☐ Welcome/Interview Meeting

The Welcome/Interview Meeting takes place with the Admissions Director, a representative of the HCS Board, and parents for the purpose of providing a brief orientation and basic information about the school, tour the campus, review the Enrollment Application, and to discuss the policies outlined in the *Parent/Student Handbook*. It is also used for conducting a general inquiry of the parents' and student's background and academic needs, Christian testimony, and interest in attending Heritage Christian School. Both parents are requested to attend and are asked to bring recent copies of their child's report cards, test scores, etc., to the Welcome/Interview Meeting.

☐ Student Entrance Test

The Student Entrance Test can be scheduled at any time before the Final Interview. A \$25 testing fee is required at the time of the testing.

□ Registration Fee

A registration fee is required at the Final Interview to ensure a student's place on the class roster.

As Heritage Christian School has a financial obligation to its employees, students shall be considered enrolled for one entire school year. Tuition will be calculated on the basis of the entire year; therefore, no reductions will be made for vacations or school holidays. If a student leaves the school for any reason or enters after the school year has begun, charges will be prorated according to the actual number of days enrolled. All withdrawals, whether before the school year begins or during the year, must be made in writing and shall be effective when such notice is delivered to the school. Families are required to reapply each year. All applications are reviewed and approved or declined before a student is re-enrolled.
