Dear Heritage Families,

It seems like the end of the second quarter came quickly this year. I pray that God has provided a good start to this new year and I look forward to all that He has in store for us in this new year. I have seen God's faithfulness in providing funds for a newer school van in this upcoming year and He continues to faithfully provide for all of our needs. This reminds me of the promise in Philippians 4:19, "And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus."

The school has been blessed this year with our new Assistant Administrator, Marc Stomprud. During the first semester, Marc was overseeing facility operations and maintenance, as well as teaching two classes and coaching basketball. Starting in this second semester, Marc will also be overseeing the Sports and Athletics programs at Heritage. It is encouraging to see how Marc is using his God-given gifts and talents to serve our students and families here at Heritage. Marc and all of our teachers and staff allow us to pursue our mission to pursue spiritual and academic excellence in all that we do.

Student Reenrollment Information for Next Year

Because you are part of the Heritage family, our assumption for next year is that you will be returning for the 2019-2020 school year. The enrollment process begins this week by completing the online reenrollment. Payment of registration, other fees, and tuition will continue to be made through the school office. To complete our online reenrollment process, you will access our ParentsWeb.

You should have received an email on this entire process. If you do not receive an email, please let us know. (These instructions are below as well.)

To access ParentsWeb: Please go to www.renweb.com

- Select **Login** from the menu bar and **ParentsWeb Login** from the drop-down menu.
- Type in your username and password. If you have forgotten your username or password, please click on the link provided.
- After logging in, click on the **Family Information** button in the left menu.
- Click on the **Enrollment/Reenrollment** button.

Our Online Enrollment system will open with a link to the reenrollment packet. The online process should take approximately 15 minutes to complete. Your information will be saved if you need to quit and come back later.

The completed enrollment and the payment of registration fees will ensure room for your child in their class if the classes become full. The class sizes are limited to 16 for pre-kindergarten, 20 for kindergarten-second grade, 22 for third-sixth grade, and 24 for seventh-twelfth grade. Classes with limited space are filled in the order outlined in the Parent/Student Handbooks. Completed enrollment and registration fees for current students or newly enrolling siblings of current students must be submitted on or before March 25, 2019 for these preferences to be applied.

Registration Fee Payment Process

For the re-enrollment process, all families must pay a registration fee each year and re-enrollment is not officially completed until that registration fee is paid. We are asking you to **re-enroll for next year before March 25, 2019.**

Continuing this year, for returning students, if the family has completed their Parent Participation volunteer positions and the registration fee is paid by March 25, 2019, the fee is reduced by \$100 per student. This means that registration for a returning student is \$250 per student if paid by March 25, 2019 or \$350 per student if paid after March 25, 2019. Newly enrolling students at Heritage (including siblings) will pay a registration fee of \$350 for their first year.

Scholarship Application Process

Financial aid is requested online using the FACTS Financial Aid Program. This information is available on the school website under admissions – scholarships. Scholarships are awarded based on need and on a first-come basis for returning families who complete the registration process (enrollment completed, registration payment made, and students accepted by HCS for admission). The Scholarship Committee will begin reviewing scholarship recommendations from FACTS on **April 1, 2019.**

Parent Participation Program

For the 2019-2020 school year, we are continuing the **Parent Participation Program.** Families will be required to sign up for at least four (4) 3-to-4 hour volunteer positions throughout the school year as part of the enrollment process. Families that have completed their volunteering positions for this year will receive a \$100 reduced registration fee if it is paid before March 25, 2019.

Tuition

There is about a 2.2% tuition increase for next year with tuition shown below. Tuition covers ski expenses for student ski days, PE gym shirts, and teacher classroom supplies. Our cost of tuition per student continues to be very reasonable when compared to public and private schools in our area. Even with this, our tuition revenue covers only about 80% of the costs to operate the school. The remaining costs are covered through fundraisers, donations, and facility use. I encourage every family to volunteer for and help coordinate our fundraisers as we use these to keep our tuition as low as possible. It also builds the Heritage family as we work side by side with others and get to know the many families that God has brought together at Heritage.
