Hello HCS Families!

Our annual Field Day Fundraiser is just around the corner! This is a fun and fit event for students striving to achieve their personal best.

The goal of this year's campaign is to help raise funds for Parent Teacher Fellowship. PTF benefits our teachers, students, and items not covered by the general budget. This year we would like to contribute to technology advancements and basic updates in our student's classrooms as well as a few miscellaneous items for our playground. Our goal this year is to raise \$16,000. That's a BIG number, but with your support, our Falcons can achieve anything! If each student is able to meet the challenge of raising \$100 in donations, we would blow our goal out of the park!

When is it?

The field day will take place on **Wednesday, May 15th from 1:30-3pm**. Since this is a Kindergarten day, Pre-K students are encouraged to come join the fun that afternoon! **Families are welcome and encouraged to come cheer and fellowship,** rain or shine!

How does it work?

The process is simple. Students will ask people to be sponsors.

- Sponsorship is a single donation. "Sponsors" are those generous folks who agree to donate money for your student's participation in the Field Day Fundraiser. They may be friends, family, neighbors, and parent's co-workers or business associates.
- Donations can also be made online. Click on the Field Day banner at heritage-christian.org.
- Cash or checks made payable to Heritage Christian School can be collected.
- Any student who participates will receive a Field Day T-Shirt to wear for the event!
- 100% of the donations benefit Heritage Christian School, teachers, and students. Since we are a nonprofit, all donations are tax deductible. You are responsible for giving each sponsor one of the attached receipts, if they would like one.

RULES

1. Students may start collecting pledges as soon as they receive the pledge sheets. Final Collection Day for K-6th is Monday, May 13th. Final Collection Day for Pre-K is Tuesday, May 14th.

NOTE: If you do not want to collect pledges, you can still participate by paying a \$12 entry fee, which includes a t-shirt.

- 2. Pledges may be made by anyone. **However, participants may not ask for pledges from any of the staff members of HCS**. Each sponsor making a pledge should write their name and pledge amount. Students are required to collect the pledge in advance but must keep those pledges until the Collection Days.
- 3. What do I need to know about Collection Days?
 - Collection Days are held in the cafeteria during the student's lunch period (except for Pre-K which we will collect in their classroom at the end of the day).
 - Pledge sheet and money need to be turned in together. A new pledge sheet will be given to the students at this time.
 - Online pledges will be tracked for each student.
 - Students will be rewarded with a prize for the first \$25 and second \$25 collected, limit of 2 prizes!

PRIZES!

1st **Prize:** Each student will be rewarded with a prize for the first \$25 in pledges collected.

2nd Prize: Each student will be rewarded with a prize for the second \$25 in pledges collected, limit of 2 prizes.

CLASS WINNER: The student who collects the most money in pledges from each classroom will receive a separate prize!

GRAND PRIZE WINNER: The student who collects the most money in pledges for the entire school will receive a grand prize!

CLASS PIZZA PARTY: Each class that raises \$1,800 or more will receive a class pizza party! **TEACHER PRIZE:** The teacher whose class raises over \$1,800 will receive a \$100 CASH GIFT!
