

### **Driver's Ed for Spring 2025**

Heritage Christian School is planning to offer a Driver Education class this spring. This class will be Montana Department of Justice certified and will meet all of Montana's requirements for Driver's Education. **We will tentatively begin classes on Monday, March 24**<sup>th</sup> **with a mandatory parent/student meeting on Thursday, March 13**<sup>th</sup> **from 6pm to 8pm.** The last class will tentatively be on May 23<sup>rd</sup>. To be eligible for the class



students must have their 15<sup>th</sup> birthday on or before September 24<sup>th</sup>, 2025 (Some leeway may be allowed on a case-by-case basis). The cost of the class will be \$400, payable to Heritage Christian School. The non-refundable payment must be made in the school office at the time of signing up to hold a spot in the class. The class will be limited to 14 students. If we do not get 14 students in the class, then we will cancel the class and your payment will be refunded to you. We plan to hold classes Monday through Thursday before school at Heritage from 6:30am to 8am. Behind-the-Wheel instruction will be held after school Monday through Thursday from 3:30pm to 5:30pm. Each student will be required to attend one session (2 hours) of Behind the Wheel instruction for each section of class. That will usually amount to one session (2 hours) each week or so for a total of 6 drives. Drives will extend after school is out, into summer for about two weeks (June 2<sup>nd</sup>). At that time the drives will be from 8am-10am and 10am-12pm. A sign-up sheet for these drives will be available at the parent meeting. If you have a student who is eligible and wishes to participate, please contact the school office at 406-587-9311.

Something new has been added by the Montana Vehicle Department (MVD) this year. They have added a "Driver's Education pre-application" to their website and request that everyone who signs up for Driver's Ed complete this application. When you do that a driver's license number will be issued to your son/daughter. To do that, go to mvdmt.gov and then click on "Online services" in the lower right-hand corner. From there go to the lower right side and click on "Complete driver's education pre-application." Then just move through the screens and fill out the appropriate info. **This should be done before the Parent's Meeting. Bring that driver's license number to the Parent's Meeting.** MVD has requested that you do this even though you will still need to fill out duplicate paperwork at the Parent's Meeting. I am told that they want this in order to double check the info that they enter into their system, and it is the only way that they will issue a driver's license number before an actual license is issued.

Please contact the office today if your student desires to join this class. The class will be officially open to outside students as of the end of today. Payment will be required to reserve your student's spot. We truly want to give priority to HCS students.
