Spring Drivers Education Information

Heritage Christian School is planning to offer a Driver Education class this spring. This class will be Montana Department of Justice certified and will meet all of Montana's requirements for Driver's Education. We will tentatively begin classes on Monday, April 1st with a **mandatory parent/student meeting on Thursday, March 28th from 6pm to 8pm.** The last class will tentatively be on May 23rd.



To be eligible for the class students must have their 15th birthday on or before October 1st, 2024 (Some leeway may be allowed on a case-by-case basis). The cost of the class will be \$400, payable to Heritage Christian School. The non-refundable payment must be made in the school office at the time of signing up to hold a spot in the class. The class will be limited to 14 students. If we do not get 14 students in the class, then we will cancel the class and your payment will be refunded to you. We plan to hold classes Monday through Thursday before school at Heritage from 6:30am to 8am. Behind-the-Wheel instruction will be held after school Monday through Thursday from 3:30pm to 5:30pm. Each student will be required to attend one session (2 hours) of Behind-the-Wheel instruction for each section of class. That will usually amount to one session (2 hours) each week or so for a total of 6 drives. Drives will extend after school is out, into summer for about two weeks (June 9th). At that time the drives will be from 8-10 and 10-12. A sign-up sheet for these drives will be available at the parent meeting. If you have a student who is eligible and wishes to participate, please contact the HCS office.

This class is filling quickly and if you are interested you must submit payment by February 1st, 2024 to guarantee your student's place in the class. **After February 1st we will be opening the class up to non HCS students.**
