

November 16th** will be our packing day in which K-6<sup>th</sup> grades will help fill boxes during chapel.



- Pre-K/K: small cars, jump ropes, yo-yos, blocks, Bible story books, balls, kites, Slinkys, plastic animals
- 1st: pens, pencils, sharpeners, notebooks, coloring books, pencil cases, colored pencils
- 2<sup>nd</sup>: markers, solar calculators, dry water colors, picture books, playdough, stickers, glue sticks
- 3<sup>rd</sup>: toothbrushes, washcloths, combs, brushes, bandages
- 4<sup>th</sup>: sunglasses, socks, jewelry, flashlights, batteries, flip flops, hats, chalk
