


## **Auditions for Peter Pan and Wendy!**

We would like to invite HCS families to participate in filling boxes for Operation Christmas Child this year. If you would like to serve in this way, consider choosing one or more items from the list to send to school with your child by **November 13**<sup>th</sup>. **November 16th** will be our packing day in which K-6<sup>th</sup> grades will help fill boxes.



- Pre-K/K: small cars, jump ropes, yo-yos, blocks, Bible story books, balls, kites, Slinkys, plastic animals
- 1st: pens, pencils, sharpeners, notebooks, coloring books, pencil cases, colored pencils
- 2<sup>nd</sup>: markers, solar calculators, dry water colors, picture books, playdough, stickers, glue sticks
- 3<sup>rd</sup>: toothbrushes, washcloths, combs, brushes, bandages
- 4th: sunglasses, socks, jewelry, flashlights, batteries, flip flops, hats, chalk
