Pre-K/K: cars, yo-yos, blocks, small Bible story books, small kites, plastic animals

1st: pens, pencils, sharpeners, small notebooks, coloring books, small pencil cases, colored pencils

2nd: markers, crayons, solar calculators, water colors, small activity or picture books, stickers

3rd: toothbrushes, washcloths, combs, brushes, bandages, hair ties

4th: sunglasses, socks, jewelry, small flashlights, batteries, flipflops, hats

5th: small stuffed animals, slinkys, fidget spinners, poppits, write a personal note in class, money for a larger gift/shipping
