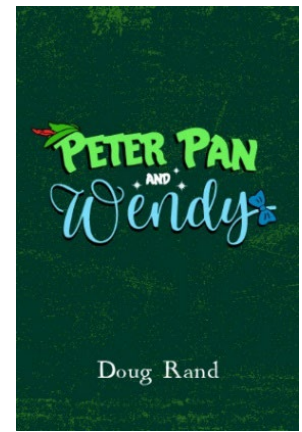

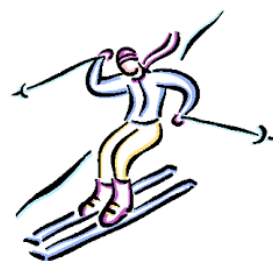

Closed Campus Policy

We have had several 10th and 11th grade students leaving campus at lunch time.

Here is our policy as stated in the HCS Handbook:

“Heritage Christian School is responsible for maintaining the safety and well-being of its students from the time they arrive at school until they leave for home. Therefore, all students are required to remain on campus during school hours, including lunch. Students may leave campus for lunch only when accompanied by a parent or other supervising adult such as a grandparent or youth pastor. Students who plan to leave school at lunch with someone other than their parents or supervising adult must present a signed request from their parents. Students in Grade 12th may leave campus when they do not have classes with written authorization on file in the office.”

Thank you, parents, for helping us keep your students safe by not giving permission unless it is necessary. Students are not allowed to leave campus and ride with other students.
