Closed Campus Policy

Heritage Christian School is responsible for maintaining the safety and well-being of its students from the time they arrive at school until they leave for home. Therefore, all students are required to remain on campus during school hours, including lunch. Students may leave campus for lunch only when accompanied by a parent or other supervising adult such as a grandparent or youth pastor. Students who plan to leave



school at lunch with someone other than their parents or supervising adult must present a signed request from their parents. Students in Grade 12 may leave campus when they do not have classes with written authorization on file in the office.
