If you would like to serve in this way, consider choosing one or more items from the list to send to school with your child by **November 13th. November 16th** will be our packing day in which K-6th grades will help fill boxes.



- **Pre-K/K:** small cars, jump ropes, yo-yos, blocks, Bible story books, balls, kites, Slinkys, plastic animals
- **1st:** pens, pencils, sharpeners, notebooks, coloring books, pencil cases, colored pencils
- **2nd:** markers, solar calculators, dry water colors, picture books, playdough, stickers, glue sticks
- **3rd:** toothbrushes, washcloths, combs, brushes, bandages
- **4th:** sunglasses, socks, jewelry, flashlights, batteries, flip flops, hats, chalk

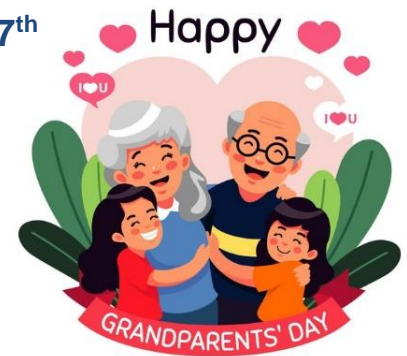
