The upcoming meetings are at 2pm:

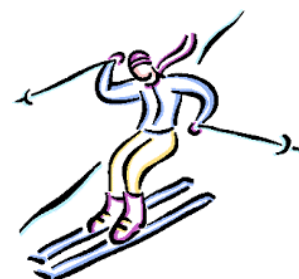
