Re Enrollment for 2026-27; Discount Deadline This Wednesday, February 25th



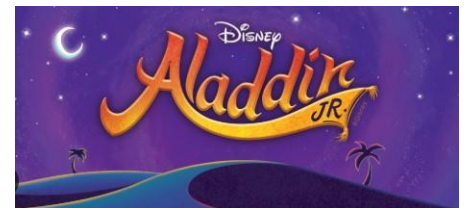
RE-ENROLLMENT
