Coaches are so proud of the diligence both during the season and at the tournament. God was honored and represented in their attitude on and off the court.

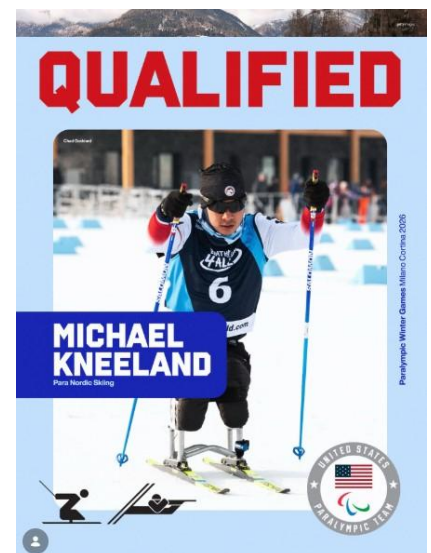

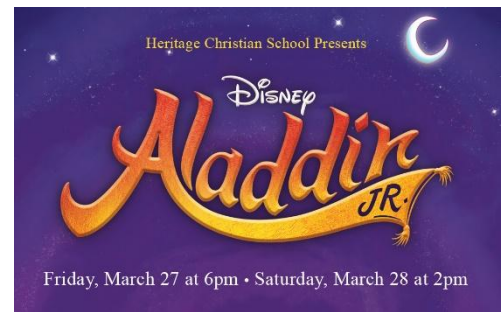
