Class Picture Day

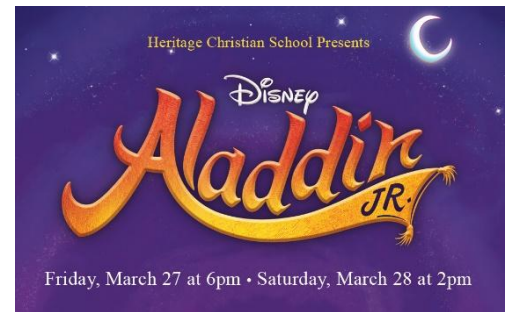
Class picture day is **Today, March 23rd, Pre-K-12th**. This is a photo of classes in their group. These photos will be included in the 2025-26 yearbook.
