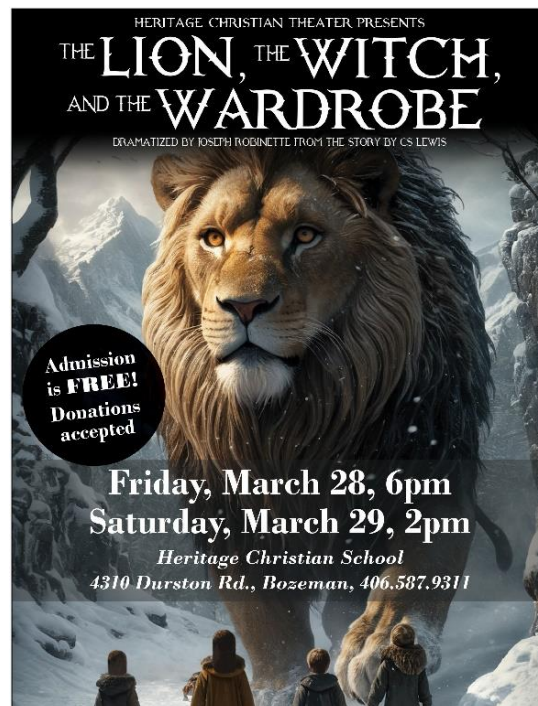
## The Lion, The Witch, And The Wardrobe!
