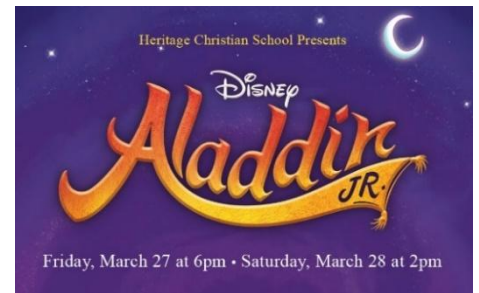
The staff and school board at Heritage Christian wish each family a wonderful Easter weekend celebrating the resurrection of our Lord and Savior.

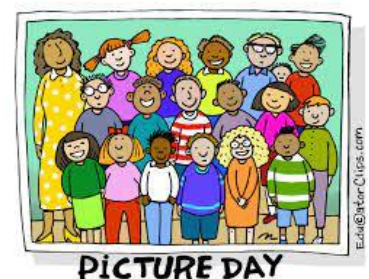
