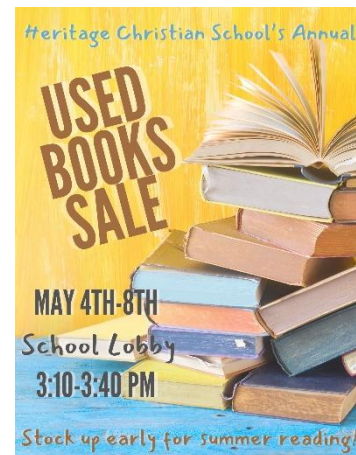
Pray for our 8th Grade DC Travelers
