Driver's Education This Fall

Heritage Christian School is considering offering a Driver Education class this Fall. This class will be Montana Department of Justice certified and will meet all of Montana's requirements for Driver's



Education. We would tentatively begin classes on Monday, August 11th with a mandatory parent/student meeting on Friday, August 8th from 6-8pm. The last class would tentatively be on Thursday, October 2nd. Drives would continue through October 6th. To be eligible for the class students must have their 15th birthday on or before February 11th, 2026 (Some leeway may be allowed on a case-by-case basis). The cost of the class will be \$400, payable to Heritage Christian School. **For Heritage students, the non-refundable payment must be made in the school office before May 30th to hold a spot in the class.** After that, the class sign-up will be open to non-Heritage students and the only way to hold a spot in the class is to pay the fee at the Heritage School office. The class will be limited to 14 students. If we do not get 14 students in the class, then we may cancel the class, and your payment will be refunded to you.

Classes will be held Monday through Thursday from 8-10am with drives scheduled after class (10am-12pm and 12-2pm) until school starts on August 28th. After school starts, class will be held from 6:30-8am with drives scheduled after school (3:30-5:30pm). Each student will be required to attend one session (2 hours) of Behind the Wheel instruction for each section of class. That will usually amount to one session (2 hours) each week or so for a total of 6 drives. A sign-up sheet for these drives will be available at the parent meeting on Friday, August 8th. Heritage Christian Letterman Jackets

We are happy to announce that Varsity Made Company has put together a website for Heritage Christian families to purchase Letterman Jackets. This company also works with the Bozeman Public Schools and is offering us a group discount if we are able to put together a group order.

The website is www.varsitymade.co. Once at the website, search schools and select Heritage Christian School for their custom builder. This builder allows students to customize their jackets with different sleeve colors, ribbon colors, patches, add first and last names, etc. If you have any questions about the custom jacket builder, please reach out to Julie Verellen: theverellens@hotmail.com. She will be the parent coordinator for any questions.

The group discount amount is \$180 off of the price of the jacket. To get the discount price it must include the first name patch, year patch, and full back patch as shown on the picture. The total price for those options is \$285/jacket with code "Heritage". Any additions such as sports patches, last name patches, etc. will be an additional charge. You can also send them the Letter patch to have sewn on the jacket. Included with the purchase is 100% wool and leather, 6-week delivery time (or faster), name on front, year patch, full back patch, and free shipping.

If you are interested in ordering the jackets locally, you can also order through Universal Athletic. They will measure the student and work with you directly. Similar options through Universal Athletic are available for around \$450.
