## Pray for our 8<sup>th</sup> Grade DC Travelers

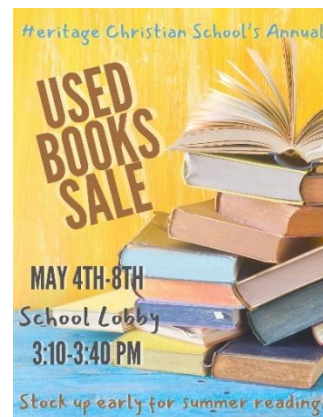
