Fall Sports Meeting


The Fall Sports meeting is Wednesday, May 14th at 3:45pm. Please come if

Update from the HCS Mission Trip 2025

The Mission Trip team of 2025 was blessed to be able to serve with the Mercy Ministerio missionary team of Cuilapa, Guatemala March 4th-12th, 2025. The Team would like to thank all who so graciously donated both financially and through Amazon purchases to the trip. The Team also thanks families who sacrificed to be able send their students on the trip. The Team shared the love of Jesus through music and skits, group activities with local youth, hospital visitation and bread provision, activities with children in the city and villages, and the sharing of testimonies and the Good News. The team also had opportunities to work in the ministry's bakery to help provide bread for the under-resourced population of the area. Both the HCS Team and the Mercy Ministerio team are so grateful to have had this opportunity.



Driver's Education This Fall

Heritage Christian School is considering offering a Driver Education class this Fall. This class will be Montana Department of Justice certified and will meet all of Montana's requirements for Driver's Education. We would tentatively begin classes on Monday, August 11th with a mandatory parent/student meeting on Friday, August 8th from 6-8pm. The last class would tentatively be on Thursday, October 2nd. Drives would continue through October 6th. To be eligible for the class students must have their 15th birthday on or before February 11th, 2026 (Some leeway may be allowed on a case-by-case basis). The cost of the class will be \$400, payable to Heritage Christian School. For Heritage students, the non-refundable payment must be made in the school office before May 30th to hold a spot in the class. After that, the class is to pay the fee at the Heritage School office. The class will be limited to 14 students. If we do not get 14 students in the class, then we may cancel the class, and your payment will be refunded to you.

Classes will be held Monday through Thursday from 8-10am with drives scheduled after class (10am-12pm and 12-2pm) until school starts on August 28th. After school starts, class will be held from 6:30-8am with drives scheduled after school (3:30-5:30pm). Each student will be required to attend one session (2 hours) of Behind the Wheel instruction for each section of class. That will usually amount to one session (2 hours) each week or so for a total of 6 drives. A sign-up sheet for these drives will be available at the parent meeting on Friday, August 8th.
