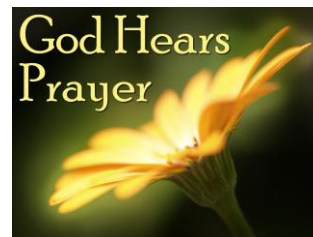
**FINANCIAL NOTE:**

Starting today, parents will be able to login to ParentsWeb to see their student's past grades and assignments for the next week. As with any new system, there will be some things that do not work as smoothly as planned. If you have any issues, please contact the office and we will work with you to resolve them as quickly as we can. We also know from experience, that there are times when the planned homework and assignments can change during the week as classes may progress differently than planned. You will enter your email and will receive a confirmation via email for a link from RenWeb. This will allow you to Create/Change your user name and password.

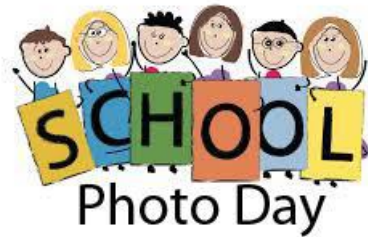
### **MCAA Tournament Coming October 25-17**
