Parents Web Update:

We are excited about the options that we have with our new School Information System - RenWeb. Parents are now able to login to ParentsWeb to see their student's past grades and assignments for the next week. As with any new system, there will be some things that do not work as smoothly as planned. We also know from experience, that there are times when the planned homework and assignments can change during the week as classes may progress differently than planned. Students are asked to still track their homework as assigned in class, as assignments may differ from the assignments that are shown in ParentWeb. To log in to Parents Web go to the above address and choose Log In/ParentsWeb Login

Type in HCS-MT as the District Code

Log in using your previous chosen user name and password

This will allow you to Create/Change your user name and password.
