Some very important things to remember when filling out your forms for this year:

- There is no cost for the Ski PE for students. This cost is covered in tuition. But, we do need each student to provide us with the necessary forms. **(Chaperones will pay a reduced fee for attending/renting- see the above prices)**
- Please complete the forms thoroughly. Each year items get missed and this causes extra time, calling to verify.
- It is imperative that the "SKIER TYPE CHART" document be reviewed. This is on the back of the rental form.
- There is no need to submit more forms than are necessary. **(If a student is not renting please do not submit a rental form.)**
- The only forms to be copied back to back are the equipment rental and skier type chart.
- All forms need to be sent to the Ski School a minimum of 2 weeks prior to your student's trip so they may plan rentals and instructors accordingly.
- Due to the timing and amount of forms we need to process in our office prior to sending to Bridger, we are asking that **all forms be complete and returned to the school no later than November 30**. Our student numbers are rising, so this would be extremely helpful to us.

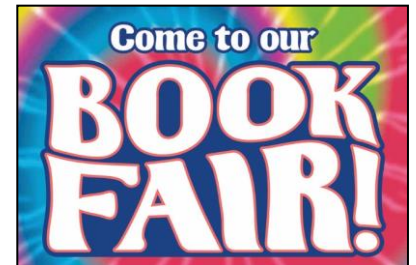


Grandparent's Day was a big hit last Friday
