Re-Enrollment for Returning Students

All families are required to re-apply for enrollment for the next school year. All applications are reviewed and approved or declined by the administrator and/or board before a student is re-enrolled. Classes with limited space are filled in order of the following preferences:

1. Children of faculty/staff.
2. Current students.
3. Siblings of returning students.
4. Former students.

All required enrollment forms **AND** registration fees for current students or newly enrolling siblings of current students must be submitted on or before March 25th or the above preferences shall be forfeited. Final acceptance of student re-enrollment shall be provided by written notification.
