Because you are part of the Heritage family, our assumption for next year is that you will be returning for the 2023-24 school year. The Reenrollment process begins, **January 25th, 2023** by completing the online Reenrollment. Payment of registration, other fees, and tuition will continue to be made through the school office.

Classes with limited space are filled in the order outlined in the Parent/Student Handbook. Completed enrollment and registration fees for current students or newly enrolling siblings of current students must be submitted on or before **February 20th, 2023** for these preferences to be applied.

Friendly Reminders

Cell phones: Students are expected to not access cell phones during the school day unless specifically instructed by a teacher to use the phone for academic purposes. If students need to communicate with parents, we ask them to come to the office (or get permission from a teacher) to use their phones to communicate as needed. Parents are always welcome to call the office with any needed information to be passed on to their student(s) as well. Thank you for your help in encouraging students to adhere to this policy.

Parking Lot: If you need to walk your child in to the building, please park in a designated parking spot instead of parking in the drop-off lane. This greatly helps in keeping the drop-off lane flowing smoothly.

As spots in the drop-off lane open in front of you, please pull up into the available spaces. This also helps keep the line moving and avoid situations where cars are pulling into the traffic lane in order to move up in to available spaces.

Have your students ready to exit your vehicle as quickly as possible when pulling up to the drop-off lane. This helps in keeping the line from backing up excessively behind you.

We realize the parking lot is crowded, especially at arrival and dismissal times. Some of these minor adjustments will be a major help in easing traffic congestion!

Drivers Education



Heritage Christian School is planning to offer a Driver Education class this spring. This class will be Montana Department of Justice certified and will meet all of Montana's requirements for Driver's Education. We will tentatively begin classes on Monday, April 3rd with a mandatory parent/student meeting on Friday, March 31st from 6pm to 8pm. The last class will tentatively be on or about May 25th. To be eligible for the class students must have their 15th birthday on or before October 3rd, 2023. The cost of the class will be \$400, payable to Heritage Christian School. The non-refundable payment must be made in the school office by March 17th to be eligible for the class. Sign-ups for the class after March 17th will be accepted on a space available basis and payment must be made at the time of signing up. We plan to hold classes Monday through Friday before school at Heritage from 6:30am to 8am. Behind-the-Wheel instruction will be held after school Monday through Friday from 3:30pm to 5:30pm and possibly on several Saturdays from 8am-10am and 10am-12pm. Each student will be required to attend one session (2 hours) of Behind the Wheel instruction for each section of class. That will usually amount to one session (2 hours) each week or so for a total of 6 drives. A sign-up sheet for these drives will be available at the parent meeting.
