FACTS Family Portal (formerly ParentsWeb) is a private and secure parent's portal that allows you to view academic information specific to your students, while protecting their information from others. You may view your student's grades, attendance, and homework as well as other useful school information.

You set up your parent portal when you went through the admissions and enrollment process.
