School Photo Make-Up/Re-take Day- Rescheduled for Tuesday, December 6th

Tuesday, December 6th will be our School Photo Re-take day for all students who missed the first photo day or for students who would like to do re-takes. Attached is the informational flyer with the code for ordering.

- If students received a picture package and want re-takes, they will need to return their original package.
- If they haven't ordered and want re-takes, they can order via online the re-take order code.
- If they were absent, they can order from the re-take order code.

If your student is doing re-takes, they must let the office know first thing that morning so we will know to pull them out of class to do this. A good idea would be to send that packet with them and have them turn it in to office when they arrive. This will ensure we know they want to re-take their photo. We have a list of students absent on the original school photo day.
