Ski PE is right around the corner! Bridger Bowl is doing registration online this year. Instructions on how to create an account and register your student have been emailed to parents of students in 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grade. Students were also sent home a paper copy in their homerooms as well as an HCS Permission slip that must be returned to the office.



This means that the only piece of paper that needs to be returned to school is the HCS Permission Form. The rest of the registration will be online. ## Revisions to Current Dress Code

The mission of Heritage Christian School is to educate students by integrating academic excellence with a biblical worldview, helping Christian families to impact the world for Christ. We are constantly seeking ways to strengthen our ability to accomplish that mission in the lives of our students and families. One of those ways included an evaluation of our current dress guidelines. The HCS School Board created a committee made up of board members, administration, teachers, parents, and current students that proposed revised dress guidelines for HCS. The proposed dress code was emailed, and some of the key revisions include:

- **Students will be allowed to wear any style of shirt that does not have inappropriate or objectionable content, fits properly, and is in good condition.**
- **Streamlined language concerning length of skirts/shorts, hair color, jewelry, and make-up.**
- **New procedures for addressing dress code violations.**

We will implement these new guidelines on a trial basis, effective immediately. We will use the remainder of this school year to identify any further revisions that may need to be made or altered. An official change in the HCS Handbook would be made next summer during the annual Handbook review.
