Drivers Education Coming Up in April

Heritage Christian School is planning to offer a Driver Education class this spring. This class will be Montana Department of Justice certified and will meet all of Montana's requirements for Driver's Education. We are tentatively scheduled to begin classes on Monday, April 25th with a mandatory parent/student meeting on Thursday, April 21st from 6pm to 8pm. The last class will be on or about June 16th. To be eligible for the class, students must have their 15th birthday on or before November 2nd, 2022. The cost of the class will be \$400, payable to Heritage Christian School, and due by the first day of class. You can bring payment to the parent meeting or pay in the school office at any time before class starts.
