Hello HCS Families!

Our annual Walk-A-Thon Fundraiser is just around the corner! Get your athletic shoes on! This is a fun and fit event for students, with all participants striving to achieve their personal best.

The goal of this year's campaign is to help raise funds for Parent Teacher Fellowship. PTF benefits our teachers, students, and items not covered by the general budget. Our goal this year is to raise \$15,000. That's a BIG number, but with your support, our Falcons can achieve anything! If each student is able to meet the challenge of raising \$100 in donations, we would blow our goal out of the park! Any amount raised over \$15,000 may be donated to areas such as playground equipment, the track, teacher's needs, or other areas where needed.

## When is it?

The Walk–A-Thon Field day will take place on Wednesday afternoon, May 18 from 1:30-3:00. Since this is a Kindergarten day, Pre-K students are encouraged to come join the fun that afternoon! **Families are welcome and encouraged to come walk and cheer throughout the afternoon,** rain or shine!

## **How does it work?**

The process is simple. Students will ask people to be sponsors.

Sponsorship is a single donation, <u>not</u> based on laps or minutes walked. "Sponsors" are those generous folks who agree to donate money for your participation in the walk-a-thon field day.

They may be friends, family, neighbors, and parent's co-workers or business associates.

Cash or checks made payable to HCS or Heritage Christian School can be collected.

100% of the donations will benefit Heritage Christian School, teachers, and students. Since we are a non-profit, all donations are tax deductible. You are responsible for giving each sponsor one of the attached receipts, if they would like one.

## **RULES**

 Students may start collecting pledges as soon as they receive the pledge sheets. Final collection day is Monday, May 16<sup>th.</sup>

NOTE: If you do not want to collect pledges, you can still participate by paying a \$12 entry fee, which includes a t-shirt.

2. Pledges may be made by anyone. However, participants may not ask for pledges from any of the staff members of HCS. Each sponsor making a pledge should write their name and pledge amount. Students are required to collect the pledge in advance, but must keep pledges until they are collected.

K-6, we will be in the lunchroom for anyone who turns in money on Wednesday May 4<sup>th</sup>, Friday May 6<sup>th</sup>, Wednesday May 11<sup>th</sup>, with Final Collection day on Monday May 16<sup>th</sup>. Pre-K collection days will be May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> and May 17<sup>th</sup> in their classroom. Prizes will be awarded to students turning money in. Your first \$25.00 collected in pledges will get you your first prize. For every additional \$25.00 collected you will receive another prize. HOW MANY CAN YOU GET!!! Please turn in a pledge sheet with your money. A new pledge sheet will be given to the students at this time. Donations made through the website will be tracked per student.
