Counting objects

Recognizing colors

Identifying shapes.

Using writing utensils accurately

Participating in group activities such as Physical Education, Music and Art

Listening while others speak

Following directions

Caring for classroom materials

Respecting others and having a positive attitude

Display self-control

These and many others are the areas of progression in Pre K.
